B. Visa Information

In order to study full-time in ELP programs, you will need a student (F-1) visa or an exchange visitor (J-1) visa—unless you are a citizen or permanent resident of the United States. If you want to study full-time but do not have an F-1 or a J-1 visa, you may have a problem entering the United States.

C. Transfer of Visa Statement

Federal regulations require that if you enter the USA on a Form I-20 issued by the University of Pennsylvania, you must attend at least one session of the ELP before you may transfer your I-20 to another institution. You will not be permitted to transfer your I-20 if you do not complete at least one session of study at the ELP first and you must report to the Office of International Programs to begin the transfer to new school process. Go to Section D.

D. Financial Support Students applying for an F-1 student visa or visa transfer should complete this section.

You need to show us that you will have enough money to pay for your tuition, fees, books, housing, food, and personal items such as clothing and toiletries. If you are coming to the United States alone, we estimate that you will need:

- Intensive Program:* \$5,450* for every 2-month session you attend at 20 hours/week
- Super-Intensive:* \$5,740* for every 2-month session you attend at 22.5 hours/week
\$6,030* for every 2-month session you attend at 25 hours/week
- Conversation & Culture:* \$2,995* for the 4-week program
- IBCP:* \$3,545* for the 4-week program
- Summer Institute:* \$4,695* for the 4-week program OR \$5,595* for the 6-week program
- All Programs:* Add \$425 per month for each person in your family who will come with you.

Please make sure that your financial support documents show sufficient funds to cover ALL the sessions you plan to attend. We can issue the Form I-20 only for the number of sessions for which you can show sufficient funds.

- I will pay for my expenses and I am enclosing a current, original (not photocopied) letter from my bank.**
- My family in my home country will pay for my expenses. I am enclosing a current, original letter from their bank.**
- My family or someone living in the United States will pay for my expenses. I want the ELP to send an Affidavit of Support (Form I-134) to the following person and address in the United States: _____

- An organization (company, government) will pay for my expenses. I am enclosing an original letter** from the organization showing how much money will be provided.

**** If the original letter is not in English, then attach an official translation.**
